



BOOKING NOTES FOR GUIDANCE

- 1. REGISTRATION FEE:** includes information pack, free entry to evening events, Sunday cake raid at Keir and administration costs. All tickets etc. to be collected from the Rally HQ, Penpont.
- 2. EVENING MEALS:** In the Gladstone Hall, Penpont. A two-course meal of excellent quality, generous helpings (main course and sweet, tea/coffee; **vegetarian option**). Catering by the Three Villages Community Café, Penpont.
- 3. OTHER MEALS:** are available from the Three Villages Community Café. The Café will be open on the evening of Thursday 22nd May for early campers. Breakfast will be available each day in the café from 8.00am and packed lunches can be ordered the day before to be collected at breakfast.
- 4. CAMPING PITCHES AND ON-SITE ACCOMMODATION:** Main Glebe Field, Penpont. Showers and toilets available in the park. There will also be a small marquee in the park for storing equipment and hanging wet clothes if necessary.

- 6. SOCIAL EVENING:** Friday 8pm, Gladstone Hall, Penpont – **FREE**. Wine, tea and coffee, juice and nibbles provided. Meet and chat with other Rallyists.
- 7. CEILDH:** Saturday 8pm, Keir Village Hall, Keir Mill - **£5.00/TICKET**. with local band “The Roving Pedlars” – locals will be joining the fun.
- 8. QUIZ:** Sunday, 8pm, Gladstone Hall – **FREE**. Join a team and pool your knowledge. Fun for everyone, including children, and Any left over wine from Friday, free tea and coffee, juice and nibbles **AND prizes!**
- 9. TOURING RIDES:** 3 graded rides daily depart Main Glebe Field, Penpont approx. 9.30am onwards, (excl. Sunday, when they depart about 10.30am for the Keir Mill Cyclists’ Cake Raid, and afterwards about 12 pm). Long rides 45 – 65 miles, medium rides 30 - 45, short rides under 30 miles (easier paced - may be suitable for families).
- 10. RIDE LEADERS:** There is will free registration for any cyclists willing to be ride leaders. Please contact David Shaw on davrshaw@aol.com
- 11. No pre-arrangements** are made for meals on rides (other than booked packed lunches – see Note 3) but we aim to stop at cafes/shops en route.
- 12. CYCLISTS' CAKE RAID:** Start from Main Glebe Field, **Sunday 11am**. Mass Ride to Keir, home of Kirkpatrick Macmillan, where there will be tea, coffee and ample home baking courtesy of the Keir Village Hall and an optional pilgrimage to the Smithy and grave.
- 13. RECEIPT:** registration **acknowledgement and other information** will be sent to e-mail addresses.
- 14. Online Routes:** Ride Routes available online as maps and downloadable GPX files through a plotaroute link. Information will be included in the e-mail Registration acknowledgement on how to download before the Rally.
